

**The “SPOOKY SPLASH” ABC Meet
Hosted By: Dearborn Dolphins
OCTOBER 14 & 15, 2006**

- Sanction:** This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc., as a timed finals meet on behalf of United States Swimming, Sanction Number MIO607006. Michigan Swimming rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as fully set forth in these meet rules.
- Location:** Carlson High School

- Times:** Saturday & Sunday Morning warm-up: 7:00 AM Events: 8:00 AM
Saturday & Sunday Afternoon warm-up: 12:00 PM or as soon as the AM Session ends, whichever occurs later.
Events: 1:00 PM or 1 hour after the start of warm-ups.
**Note: 11-12 GIRLS, 13-14, AND OPEN SWIM IN THE MORNING
8 & UNDER, 10 & UNDER, 11-12 BOYS SWIM IN THE AFTERNOON**
- Facilities:** Romulus is an 8 lane pool. Depth at start is 8.5 ft. and 4 feet at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers are in place. The electronic timing system is a Colorado Timing system with touch pads. The scoreboard has an 8 lane alpha numeric read out. There is bleacher seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). The 25 yd. events will be swum from the blocks. Public phones will be available.
- Eligibility:** This DRD Meet is for all swimmers. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States Swimming (USS). Swimmer's age on October 14, 2006 will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group. A swimmer may sign up for a maximum of 5 individual events per day, plus 2 relays.
- Entry Limits:** **Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis, by date of electronic entry and reception of signed waiver and check (as described in Entry Procedures) until the Michigan Swimming four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned. To balance sessions to meet the four (4) hour per session time limit, the Meet Referee and Meet Director reserve the right to apply any or all of the following: (i) split age groups, or (ii) split teams. No deck entries will be accepted. If the Meet Referee or Meet Director desires to split age groups and/or split teams, the contact person for each club entering the meet and each unattached swimmer shall be provided with electronic notification of such change at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the meet. Any club that withdraws entries based on such change shall receive a refund of such entry fees.**
- Awards:** Awards will be given for places 1-12 for individual events, 1-6 for relays.
Awards must be picked up by the end of the meet – they will not be mailed!
- Entry Fees Electronic:** \$4.00 per individual event and \$12.00 for relays. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: **DRD**
- Entry Fees Paper Entry:** Michigan Swimming rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. **There is a \$1.00 additional charge per swimmer per event paid to the Host Club.** The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 surcharge for each swimmer will also apply.

Entry Procedures: Entries may be submitted to the entry chairperson as of Saturday, September 16, 2006. The entry chairperson must receive all entries NO LATER THAN Friday, October 6, 2006. Entries must include swimmer name (no nicknames, official registered names must be used), age and USS number. You can import the order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website (www.uss-michigan.com). ENTRY TIMES MUST BE SUBMITTED IN YARD TIMES. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail in Hy-tek format to the entry chairperson at MLANEGREEN@AOL.COM Any entries submitted via email will be considered provisional until the entry chairperson has received a hard copy of the signed waiver agreement (a form of which is attached hereto) and a check for the entry fee. If the check and signed waiver are not received within one week of submission of the electronic entries, the provisional status shall lapse and the entries will not be considered to have been received until the date on which the check and signed waiver are actually received. The complete DRD Spooky Splash entry packet with entry forms is available on the Michigan Swimming Website at www.uss-michigan.com. UPDATED ENTRY TIMES ONLY may be submitted to the entries chairperson by e-mail at MLANEGREEN@AOL.COM NO LATER THAN October 9, 2006. No new entries may be included with the updated times.

Check In: Check-In will be available as of 15 minutes prior to the start of warm-ups for each session and will close 15 minutes after the start of warm-ups. **CHECK-IN MUST COMPLY WITH THE MICHIGAN SWIMMING APPROVED CHECK-IN RULES.** Failing to swim an event after check-in will disqualify a swimmer from his or her next event. No deck check-in will be permitted.

Marshaling: The meet will be marshaled ONLY for the 8 and under swimmers. All other events will be self-marshaled. 8 and under swimmers and their coaches will be responsible for reporting to the marshaling area when their event is called. If a swimmer in an event cannot be at the marshaling area when an event is called, another representative from such swimmer's team (swimmer, coach, etc.) should report to the marshaling area for such swimmer. Each swimmer must check in prior to the specified time or be scratched from their events.

Seeding: All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest. After a swimmer has checked in and is seeded, that swimmer must compete in that event or such swimmer will be scratched from his/her next scheduled event.

Admissions: \$3 per person over the age of 12 on Saturday and Sunday. 12 & under are free. Programs will be \$6.

Scoring: No individual or team scoring will be kept.

Results: Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at www.uss-michigan.com, and also on the Dearborn Dolphins Website at www.swimdrd.org. Additional copies of the results can be ordered at the admissions table for \$5.00.

Concessions: Food and beverages will be available in the Concessions area. No food or beverages (other than water) will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas. A

hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials.

Lost and Found:

Articles may be turned in/picked up at the Awards Table. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained in the home of the Meet Director for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

Swimming Safety:

Michigan Swimming warm-up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers will be required to enter feet first into the pool except when sprint lanes have been designated. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee. There will at all times be at least three (3) marshals monitoring during all warm-ups. All such marshals will be members of United States Swimming.

Deck Personnel: Only swimmers, registered coaches, meet officials, and workers are allowed on the deck. Coaches and officials must display their registration cards at all times. Coaches must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities:

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests, please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm-ups.

Info:

Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the Meet Referees and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches' review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.

First Aid:

Supplies will be kept in Marshaling.

Facility Items:

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Carlson High School.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the Computer Tower on Deck.

[Waiver Agreement]

Illegal entry means entry of an unregistered athlete into a Michigan Swimming sanctioned competition.

The authority for these actions is:

UNITED STATES SWIMMING RULES AND REGULATIONS 302.4 FALSE REGISTRATION. A LSC may impose a fine up to \$100.00 per event against a member or coach or a member club representative signing a document which indicates a swimmer is registered with United States Swimming for a meet when the swimmer is not properly registered. This will be enforced by LSC and the LSC will be entitled to the fines imposed.
