Facilities: Wayne States' pool is an eight (8) lane pool with a diving well which will be available for supervised warm-up and warm down during the **PM session** only.. Depth at start is 7 and 4 at turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. Colorado timing with an 8 lane display will be used.. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). Public phones are not available.

Eligibility: Leroy Dues Swim Club Holiday Splash is for all A,B,C swimmers All swimmers must be currently registered with United States of America Swimming (USA). A swimmer's age on December 16th will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group.

Meet Format: The swimmers are grouped by age and gender: 8 and under, 10 & under, 11 & 12, 13 & 14 and Open. The time standards used in this meet is

A,B,C. The “8 & under, 10 & under, 11 & 12 **Girls** are in the **morning session**. The, 11 & 12 **Boys**, 13 & 14 and Open events are in the **afternoon sessions**.

Entry Limits: Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis by date of email for electronic entries and date of receipt by the entry chair for hard copy entries until the Michigan Swimming four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. As set forth in Entry Procedures below, entries are not deemed valid and will not be processed until such time as the entry chairperson has received: (a) a hard copy of your club's entry summary sheet, (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your clubs certification of entered athletes and (d) your club's entry and entry fees. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned **even if received before the entry deadline**. To balance sessions to meet the four (4) hour per session time limit, the meet host reserves the right to use any reasonable technique including but not limited to splitting age groups and/or splitting teams. If the meet host desires to either split age groups and/or split teams, the contact person of each club entering the meet and each unattached swimmer shall be provided with electronic notification of such change at least ten (10) days prior the date of the meet. Any club that withdraws entries based on such change shall receive a refund of such entry fees.

Individual Entry Limits: USA Swimming rules permit no more than 4 individual events per day in a timed finals format and one (1) relay event per day on Saturday and Sunday.

Electronic Entries: \$4.00 per individual event and \$10.00 for relays. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: **Leroy Dues Swim Club**

Paper Entries: MS rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. \$5.00 per individual event and \$11.00 for relays. There is a \$1.00 additional charge per individual event and \$1.00 per relay event paid if the entry is not submitted on Hy-Tek (or compatible) disk. The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge for each swimmer also applies to paper entries. Paper entries may be submitted to the entry chair on a spreadsheet of your choice however the paper entry *must* be logically formatted and must contain all pertinent information to allow the entry chair to easily enter the swimmer(s) in the correct events with correct seed times.

Entry Procedures: Entries may be submitted to the entry chairperson as of November 17th The entry chairperson must receive all entries no later than Saturday November 18th. Entries must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. You can import the

order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website (www.uss-michigan.com). All entries should be submitted on disk in Hy-Tek format.. All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail to the entry chairperson at fishjenks@yahoo.com Please submit a hard copy of the entries on a disk. Any entries submitted will not processed on an "as received basis", but when the entry chairperson has received a hard copy of: (a) a hard copy of your club's entry summary sheet, (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your clubs signed certification of entered athletes and (d) your club's entry and entry fees. The complete **Leroy Dues Swim Club Holiday Splash** entry packet with entry forms is available on the Michigan Swimming Website at www.uss-michigan.com.

Refunds: Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair there are no refunds in full or in part.

Relays Relay events are offered for 8 & under mixed, 10 & under mixed, 11 & 12 Boys, 11 & 12 Girls, 13 & 14 Girls, 13 & 14 Boys, Open Girls, and Open Boys. There are no relay-only swimmers. All relay participants must Also swim at least one individual event.

Check In: Check In will be available 30 minutes before the start of warm-ups. Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Check in will close 15 minutes before the beginning of events. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from **all** events in that session. PLEASE FOLLOW THE POSTED CHECK IN PROCEDURE AND MICHIGAN SWIMMING CHECK IN RULES. Also note that pursuant to MS Rules that failing to swim an event after checking in for that event will disqualify a swimmer from his or her next event. Check in sheets will be posted in the Gym (Room109).

Scratch Rules: Prior to check in closing, a swimmer may scratch events at the Clerk of Course. After check in closes, you must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event. Once a swimmer has checked in for an event that swimmer

must compete in that event or the swimmer will be scratched from his/her next event.

Marshaling: The meet will be marshaled for the AM sessions only. 8 & U, 10 & U will be marshaled in the gym (Room109). Swimmers will be responsible for reporting to the marshaling area when their event is called. Once a swimmer has reported to the marshaling area and is seeded, that swimmer must compete in that event or such swimmer will be scratched from his/her next scheduled event.

Seeding: Seeding will be done after check in closes. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event will be scratched from that event. All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest .

Deck Entries/ Deck entries may be accepted at the Clerk of the Course and may swim if time and space permit in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet Director.

Time Trials: Deck entry and time trial swimmers are subject to the Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge.

Meet Programs/ Admissions: \$5.00 per person per day. Children 10 and under free with an adult. Meet program will be available for 2 days for \$8,00.

Scoring: No scoring will be kept

Results: Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at www.uss-michigan.com. Results will also be available on disk (HY-TEK Meet Manager) upon request. Teams providing a formatted 3.5" disk will receive a results diskette.

Concessions: Food and beverages will be available in the gymnasium (Room109). No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool, in the locker rooms or in the spectator areas.

Hospitality. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials (Dance Studio).

Lost and Found: Articles may be turned in/picked up in the Gymnasium (Room109) Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

Swimming Safety: Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. [The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well]. Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the meet referee which may include ejection from the meet.

Deck Personnel: Only swimmers, registered coaches and meet officials/workers are allowed on the deck. Coaches and officials must display their registration cards at all times. Coaches must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities: All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

General Info: Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.

First Aid: Supplies will be kept at the **AWARDS TABLE**.

Facility Items:

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of the Matthaei Building.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to marshalling awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the BUILDING office.

Certification of Entered Athletes

Group members must submit full registries and dues prior to entering any sanctioned competition. A penalty fee of \$100.00 per illegal athlete will be levied against any group member found to have illegally entered a non-member athlete in a meet and also subject the athlete and Club to MS Board of Review sanctions. Illegal entry means entry of an unregistered athlete into a Michigan swimming sanctioned competition.

The authority for these actions is:

UNITED STATES SWIMMING RULES AND REGULATIONS 302.4 FALSE REGISTRATION. A LSC may impose a fine up to \$100.00 per event against a member or coach or a member club representative signing a document which indicates a swimmer is registered with USA Swimming for a meet when the swimmer is not properly registered. This will be enforced by LSC and the LSC will be entitled to the fines imposed.
